Albert Oehlen's work is the subject of a solo exhibition at Galerie Max Hetzler, Berlin, from 12 June until 8 August 2026.

Untitled, 1992/2005, belongs to Albert Oehlen's celebrated series of 'Computerbilder' (Computer Paintings). Oehlen began this body of work derived from computer-generated motifs in 1991, making him one of the first artists to incorporate the digital into the realm of painting. For this series, Oehlen employed basic computer programmes to make onscreen drawings, before enlarging and printing them onto canvas as silkscreens, encouraging the original drawings to pixelate and rupture. He then 'corrected' the compositions by hand, corrupting the electronic patterns with manual, painterly gestures. In this way, the authenticity of the drawing becomes compromised by the machine's low resolution, while the authenticity of the machine is in turn destroyed by the artist's hand.

The present work was exhibited in Oehlen's major institutional presentation of Computer Paintings at the Hamburger Kunsthalle, 2024–2025. Examples from the series are in the collections of the Art Institute of Chicago; Fondation Louis Vuitton, Paris; Hill Art Foundation, New York; Los Angeles County Museum of Art; Museum Brandhorst, Munich; Pinault Collection, Paris & Venice; The Broad, Los Angeles; and ZKM | Center for Art and Media, Karlsruhe, among others.





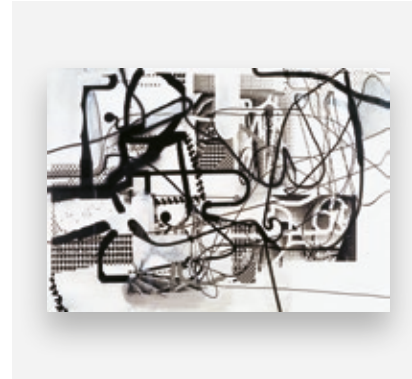

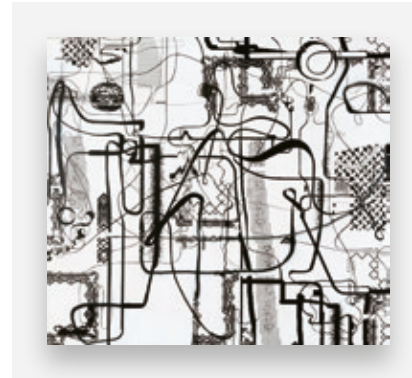

'My grey paintings are about giving the picture a painterly treatment that has nothing to do with depicting a subject, but rather aims through the subject back toward the point of departure. Which was to produce a beautiful abstract painting. Richter paints his motifs in a kind of blurry motion that seems to originate within the viewer, who wants to look away but can't. I want to drag the viewer head-on through the picture.'

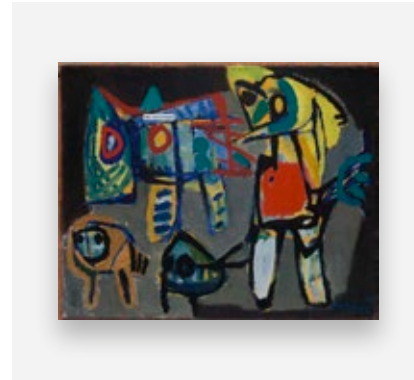

WALTON FORD

born 1960 in Westchester County, New York, USA
lives and works in New York, USA

Walton Ford's work will be the subject of an upcoming solo exhibition at Galerie Max Hetzler, London, opening September 2026.

In *Outward and outward and forever outward*, 2026, Walton Ford presents four richly detailed wolves. Depicted from a low vantage point, they loom over the viewer. The painting, Ford explains, is about the 'beauty and freedom' of overcoming the fear of death. Its title draws from an excerpt in Walt Whitman's poem 'Song of Myself', from his celebrated collection *Leaves of Grass*, first published in 1855. The work is part of a new series of cinematic depictions of wolves, set against dramatic, expansive skies. Inspired by the cloud architecture in Giovanni Battista Tiepolo's (1696–1770) ceiling frescoes, Ford notes: 'I wanted to see if I could create the sensation of looking up, past the wolves and into the heavens.'

Ford's works are in the collections of the Albertina, Vienna; Bowdoin College Museum of Art, Brunswick; Crystal Bridges Museum of American Art, Bentonville; Currier Museum of Art, Manchester; Montclair Art Museum; The Museum of Fine Arts, Houston; The Museum of Modern Art, New York; New Britain Museum of American Art; New York Public Library; Princeton University Art Museum; San Antonio Museum of Art; Smithsonian American Art Museum, Washington, D.C.; Wadsworth Atheneum, Hartford; and Whitney Museum of American Art, New York, among others.

'The *incomprehensible brown paintings* [u.b.B.] also refer to existing art and to a period close to cubism, namely early modernism. Here I asked myself a few simple questions: If something is abstract, why is it brown? How does this brown palette come in, which would obviously make more sense if you were painting nature? Is it intentional or is it something that's being dragged along? With cubism, of course, it's clear that it refers to figurative inspirations – still lifes and the like. It's obvious that certain colours seem to be predetermined. But that doesn't have to be the case.'
