# ÖZGÜR KAR & KATE SPENCER STEWART Art Basel Miami Beach

Emalin is pleased to present new works by Özgür Kar (b. 1992 in Ankara, TR) and Kate Spencer Stewart (b. 1984 in Phoenix, AZ, US). The presentation comprises drawings and two multimedia sculptures by Özgür Kar and oil paintings on linen by Kate Spencer Stewart.


Kate Spencer Stewart is a painter working with the hesitations, suspicions and instincts of abstraction and refusal, representing her attempt to paint "nothing, or the void". Her works, usually in oil and tempera on linen canvases, are always square as a gesture of avoiding to suggest the representation of either portraiture or landscape. The squares range between vast fields and focused vignettes, as if switching between the surface of an ocean and a teacup. Her process unfolds through repetitive mark-making on top of underpaintings that are often in secret contrast with the final coat: she re-examines and reiterates the surface with overlays of crushed pigment and iridescent oil. Drawn to the impossibilities of capturing ambience, hum and atmosphere, Stewart layers the earthiest and most synthetic pigments to offer a view toward transcendence.

Özgür Kar's works are animated sculptures: their physical screens as much a part of the work as the minimalist video and sound. Drawing reference from 90s cartoons, medieval woodcuts and absurdist theatre, each screen is like a theatre character, playing its part in an ensemble. Stoic and meditative, his barely-moving drawings speak in existentialist and humorous phrases that loop imperceptibly, turning videos into sculptures locked within the edge of television screens. They speak about death and anxiety – in more or less direct terms – and the words they use are pulled from the online vocabulary people express themselves with in contemporary life. With his camp, macabre, anxious figures and theatrical sets, Kar searches for a new language with which to speak of our timeless fears.

Working in disparate mediums, the artists share a meditative attention to an illusion of banality: the banality of abstract painting and the banality of death. Together, their works explore the potential of void and darkness as generative site. Through their contemplative focus on surface – the surface of a TV screen or the surface of a colour field painting – what could be superficial becomes a window into an infinitely more mysterious existentialism.



The sounds of birdsong and buzzing flies infest Kar's recent body of works. With the depiction of fallen birds, he turns to the sentimental image of a garden scene or a musical nocturne: a romantic vision of longing and despair. Meanwhile, the flies escaping through the threshold of a door left ajar refer to the Musca Depicta: the 15th and 16th century trope of death and rot in Flemish painting.




With an interest in creating a synthetic space of void, Stewart's canvases vary in their evocations – from night skies and the flutter of feathers to the depths of a well. Her process begins with a detailed reference that, working across multiple paintings simultaneously, work off one another in a kind of feedback loop, with each proceeding through layered processes that contain many entry points.


