


'The directness of the lines – the curves, straightforward and smudged hatching – creates a figure, which (for me) remains unique. The balance in the coherence of the lines is as precarious as that of a wire mobile. On the other hand, they create the ground plan of a maze in which the openings merely imply turning back. One is drawn into a labyrinth. In an interview with Troels Andersen, Mancoba refers to the precarious position of the artists in the community:

... because even today, with all our science, with all we think we know, we don't know the future, we don't know the tomorrow, with all our knowledge; and we are faced with this thing, and we are in perpetual anguish, and the artist, the poet, these people who do not just use mathematical reasoning, pose before us what we are responsible to do.

The crisp delineation of the image is in contrast with an inaccessible, but centrally placed, scribbled blotch. This dark blemish yields its mystery only when it is placed next to an image of the crucified Christ in R. Broby-Johansen's book: *Den Dance Billedbible i Kalkmalerier.* Christ's ribcage with its wound and spear is evocative of the horizontal bands, scribbled blotch and crooked line. No symbol is explicit in Mancoba's art, but the signs remain open for interpretation.'










