C L E A R I N G is pleased to present Maison CLEARING, an exhibition featuring works by an international and intergenerational group of 44 artists — including long-time collaborators and newcomers to the gallery — curated by writer and art critic Olamiju Fajemisin and opening on Sunday, June 15, 4–9pm at Bannwartweg 39, 4058 Basel.

Sprawling across all four stories and (almost) every room of a historic and charming family home, Maison CLEARING unfolds as a "gesamt-exhibition" — an anthology of exhibitions — rather than a singular, cohesive presentation.

Installed in unexpected configurations, the broad selection of paintings, sculptures, moving-image, and site-specific works explores variations on the unambiguous theme of domesticity, including notions of value and voyeurism, inherent to the exhibition's context. Maison CLEARING thus reimagines what a gallery space can be, both thematically and architecturally. It puts the artworks in conversation with their surroundings, rather than detaching from them. Through this interdisciplinary exploration of art and spatiality, Maison CLEARING invites guests to reconsider the essence of a house and what makes it a home — reimagining both the traditional gallery and art fair models by challenging what it means to live with art.

Gabrielė Adomaitytė (b. 1994, Kaunas, Lithuania) lives and works in Brussels, Belgium and Amsterdam, Netherlands.

She received her BA from Vilnius Academy of Arts, Lithuania in 2017, then she was artist in residence at De Ateliers, Amsterdam from 2017-19.
