Bambou Gili and Dan John Anderson May 8 - 11, 2025

For Independent 2025, Night Gallery is delighted to present a solo booth of new paintings by Bambou Gili. The artist renders animals, figures, and the earth itself with equal care. Her compositions tenderly address contemporary ecological issues such as animal extinction and nature's evolution across the seasons. Gili's new canvases focus on water sources and on birds, as the artist simultaneously looks towards the earth and sky. While fires rage and water scarcity increases around the planet, Gili's vivid, imaginative scenes lead viewers to rethink their own relationship to our shifting landscape.

Three new paintings unite Gili's engagements with climate apocalypse and the female figure. *Dionysian Procession* features a procession of nude, purple figures who resemble Grecian sculptures. They march in communion, in front of a blood red landscape. Two other canvases feature lone purple and blue figures, alternately grieving and glowing. "Lately, when I'm painting landscapes, I feel like I'm painting a ghost," Gili says. Her paintings suggest communion and resilience as the best paths forward.

In addition to debuting new paintings by Bambou Gili, Night Gallery will showcase hand-carved furniture by Dan John Anderson. Based in the desert of Yucca Valley, CA, Anderson will present a solo exhibition of new work at Night Gallery in the summer of 2025. His works transcend the traditional boundaries of sculpture, furniture, and totem, consistently celebrating the spiritual essence of wood. Through his craft, natural elements are reshaped into innovative forms that foster community and shared experiences.

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
